

DUNMORE LANG COLLEGE 2009 POSTGRADUATE & FINAL YEAR HONOURS FEES SCHEDULE

This Schedule details postgraduate fees for 2009 and should be read in conjunction with the Admissions Document and College Handbook, the three documents comprising a residential contract with the College. It applies to all postgraduate and final year honours students of Macquarie University with a 2009 Residential Agreement with the College who reside at the College from January 2009 onwards. There are separate Fees Schedules for undergraduate students and Resident Advisers.

There are two categories of fees: **Initial Fees and Accommodation Fees.**

* **Initial Fees** must be paid by the date set in the College's letter of offer to secure a place.

* **Accommodation Fees** must be paid on or before the day of arrival each semester. Keys will not be given unless these have been paid. Two payment schemes are in place for Accommodation Fees: (1) by direct payment of the full amount into our bank, cheque, cash or credit card, or (2) by direct debit through the PaySmart system, spreading the payment equally over the contracted period. Details are provided in the Offer documents. No refund of fees is offered throughout the year, except in exceptional circumstances, approved by the Principal.

NOTES

- Initial Fees are non-refundable except the Accommodation Deposit, refunded less costs on final departure. This amount is **not** refunded if you withdraw from College for any reason before the end of your Contract.
- Residents can request to withdraw prior to the end of their Contract from the College but must give four weeks notice. If they are breaking their Contract they will lose the Accommodation Deposit and may be liable for all
- New postgraduate fees for 2009 commence 1 January for new students and after lunch on Sunday 15 February 2009 for continuing students.
- Accommodation Styles**
 - Fully-catered:** Mansfield & McCredie Wings: single studybedroom with shared communal bathroom. Miller Wing: single studybedroom sharing an ensuite bathroom with another resident. Some rooms have balconies. Miller and Doust Private Ensuite: single studybedroom with private ensuite. Some rooms have balconies.
 - Self-catered:** DLC Postgraduate Apartments, 159 Herring Road. Other dining, see below '8'. One BR: large one BR apartment, kitchen, bathroom, dining room/lounge, bedroom (queen size bed), internet, balcony; Two BR: two BR (one queen, one single), desks, kitchen, bathroom, dining room/lounge, internet, balcony. Fans provided. Proximity access to outside doors. Communal laundry. Common areas cleaned by College staff. Option to pay for regular cleaning. Apartments cleaning checked weekly at first, then fortnightly. Linen packs available for purchase.
- Fees shown include GST at the applicable rate.
- Postgraduate students, wherever they are resident in College, are automatically members of the MU Sports and Aquatic Centre and receive the College's unlimited download service. Self-catered members receive Sunday evening dinner in the College, attendance at the Commencement and Valedictory Dinners and are eligible to attend the Principal's DeLeCtable dinners. There are opportunities for academic tutoring of undergraduate residents. For fuller information (eg on linen, crockery, etc) please see the Postgraduate and Honours Information Sheet.
- Fees are set by the Dunmore College Board and are not negotiable. Rates shown are based on continuous occupancy throughout the academic year and represent a discounted rate for such. There is no "weekly rental" basis.
- Rates shown include Sunday evening dinner in College. Self-catered postgraduate and honours students may also eat in the Dining Hall on a meal by meal paid basis at any time.
