

DUNMORE LANG COLLEGE 2009 UNDERGRADUATE FEES SCHEDULE

This Schedule details fees, institutions and dates for 2009 fees and should be read in conjunction with the Admissions Document and College Handbook, the three documents comprising a Residential Contract with the College. It applies to all undergraduate students with a 2009 Residential Agreement with the College who reside at the College from February 2009 onwards. This includes Study Abroad and Exchange program students, and students studying at the SIBT (Sydney Institute of Business and Technology). There are separate Fees Schedules for Postgraduate Students (including final year Honours Students) and Residential Advisers. See the website for a chart comparing costs of collegiate and non-collegiate accommodation.

There are two categories of fees: **Initial Fees and Accommodation Fees.**

* **Initial Fees** must be paid by the date set in the College's letter of offer to secure a place.

* **Accommodation Fees** must be paid on or before the day of arrival each semester. Keys will not be given unless these have been paid. Two payment schemes are in place for Accommodation Fees: (1) by direct payment of the full semester amount into our bank, cheque, cash or credit card, or (2) by direct debit through the PaySmart system, spreading the payment equally over the contracted period. Details are provided in the Offer documents. No refund of fees is offered throughout the year, except in exceptional circumstances, approved by the Principal.

RECESS ACCOMMODATION

Residential Contracts do not include recesses within the academic year. Residents can **guarantee** a place by completing the relevant section on the Admissions Document when accepting an offer. All other recess accommodation is at the College's discretion, depending on conference and maintenance requirements.

NOTES

- Initial Fees are non-refundable except the Accommodation Deposit, refunded less costs on final departure. This amount is **not** refunded if you withdraw from College for any reason before the end of your Contract.
- An Advance Payment of \$500 is required as part of Initial Fees. It represents a down payment which is credited against your fees for 2nd Semester. It is **not** refunded or credited if you withdraw before the end of your Contract.
- The Enrolment Fee varies for second and later year undergraduates. It is weighted according to academic progress, with reductions per university unit (or equivalent) achieved at Pass or higher grade.
- You can request to break your Contract of residence but you will forfeit the Accommodation Deposit, 2nd Semester Advance and remain liable for all contracted fees.
- Returning residents arrive in College **three** days later in 1st semester and **six** days later in 2nd semester. Their accounts will be credited for these days at the beginning of each semester.
- New fees for 2009 commence after lunch on Sunday 15 February 2009 and continue until before lunch Sunday 14 February 2010.
- Room types: Mansfield & McCredie: single studybedroom with shared communal bathroom. Miller Wing: single studybedroom sharing an ensuite bathroom with another resident. Some rooms have balconies. Miller and Doust Private Ensuite: single studybedroom with private ensuite. Some rooms have balconies.
- Fees shown include GST at the applicable rate.
- ADS stands for 'The Association of Dunmore Lang Students', which provides social and recreational activities and leadership opportunities through multiple committees.
- Fees are set by the Dunmore College Board and are not negotiable. Rates shown are based on continuous occupancy throughout the academic year and represent a discounted rate. There is no "weekly rental" basis.
- Length of Contract: students are accepted into residence on Contracts for the full academic year, unless (rarely) other arrangements are agreed with the Principal.
